Paper Pieced Miniature Quilt –Detail of Fussy Cuts

**Need three contrasting fabric scraps (at least a fat quarter for sashing & border). Plus fabric or novelty print to make fussy cuts: 1.5" square plus seam allowances. Flannel is used for batting but you do not need to bring to class.



Sample at left is machine paper pieced & machine quilted.

13.5" X 17.25"

Other Supplies to bring to workshop:

Sewing machine with neutral thread. Iron & pad with extension cord. Cutting matt, ruler, rotary cutter. Small ruler with ¼" markings.

Scissors (fabric & paper), pins, glue stick, seam ripper, 4" square of template plastic, hand sewing needle (I use Size 10, quilting needle), thimble, Sharpie pen, hand sewing thread for Broderie Perse. Fusible Web for applique of novelty print on Strip Pieced mini if not planning to do hand, Broderie Perse.



Strip pieced Miniature Quilt with Applique (Broderie Perse). Can use Raw Edge, Fused Applique.

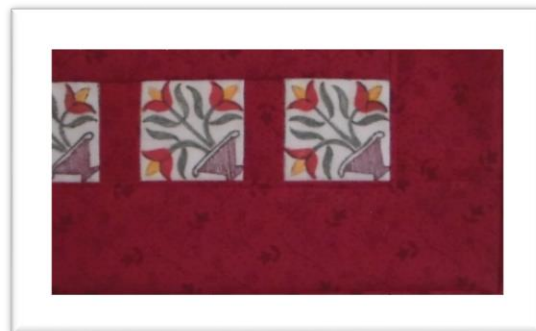
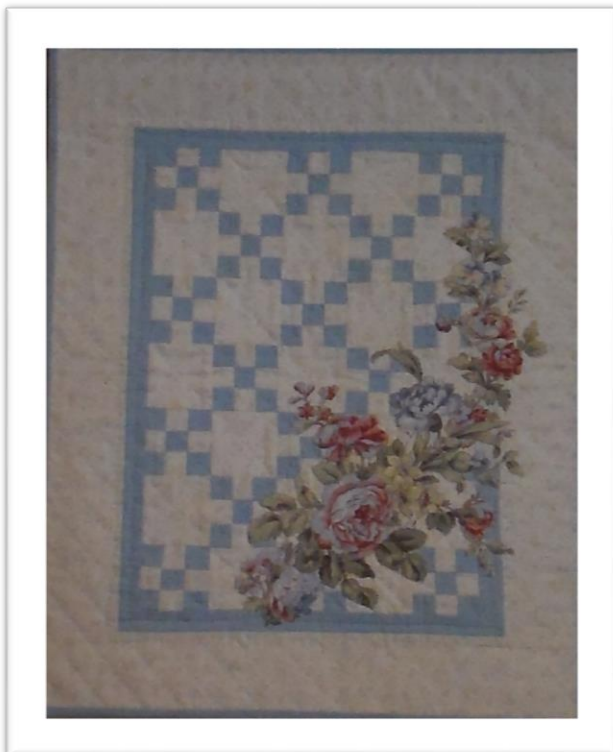
**Need two contrasting fabrics for Irish Chain: cut three, 1 1/8" strips the width of fabric of each color. Cut 17, 2 3/8" squares of light fabric for alternate blocks. Extra fabric for border: I used 3" wide strip for outer border and 1.25" wide for inner border. Extra fabric for binding cut

1" wide. Need nice sized novelty print or floral to use as applique.

Sample is machine pieced. Hand Broderie Perse. Hand quilted.



Measures 15" X 18.5"



Rubber Stamped Miniature Quilt Blocks

Colored with Micron Pigma Pens

Sample is machine pieced & machine quilted.
