



Dyeing for a Landscape
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Can you believe that it is possible to dye fabric and make it into a landscape in one short day? You will learn how to instantly dye silk and use luscious layers of it to make a beautiful Florida scene in this one day class. Bonnie will teach you how to dye the silks, build a landscape and machine stitch a few details. You will have the freedom to rearrange your sunset/sunrise scene. This is just a sample suitable for framing. Come ready for fun and amazement!

For a kit fee of \$20 you will have everything you need short of a few basic supplies:

Supply List:

Please be sure you (and your machine!) know how to stitch in free motion mode. Practice before class if you've never done this. No perfect stitching is needed.

Sewing machine capable of dropping feed dogs, using a darning or free motion foot with a wide hole for zig zag stitching, bring your manual

Glue sticks-not purple

General sewing supplies

Thread

black bobbin thread (optional)

black top thread (may be used in the bobbin, too)

Solid black fabric approx. 8x12"

Solid white fabric approx. 12x12"

Lightweight fusible such as Lite Steam a Seam 2, Misty Fuse

*Wear old clothes, just in case!
