Workshop:

Small Poppy

Skill Level: All

Sewing Machine required

Class description: In this class you will learn the appli-piecing technique I have used for many years to produce my larger floral compositions. You will use watercolor pencils to add additional color and dimension. We will do a little free motion quilting or quilting with a walking foot if desired and you will learn my way of applying a facing.

The project is small enough to finished in one day. .



Supplies:

For stem and leaves - 5" square of two greens, one darker than the other

For background - Four 5" squares of blue or purple fabric with a subtle pattern, like a batik or tone on tone, a small patterns or black and whites with small to medium pattern will also work.

For flower pedals, A hand dye in orange, or red, or .yellow, or pink. Choose a flower color that stands out from background. Needs to be lighter or darker than your background color or a compliment to your background color.

For Backing-One 12" square piece for backing ,

For facing - Four 3" x 12" strips.

Thread to match fabrics

Small cutting board, ruler and cutter

Supply fee: Pattern, glue stick, interfacing, wool felt, batting, use of watercolor pencils and acrylic paint. \$5.00
