Foundation Appliqué - Mandala

All Day – All levels

Learn Karen's go-to method for machine appliqué. In class you will learn the foundation paper turned edge style of appliqué. Karen will share some tricks for creating perfect points as well as smooth curves.

Once your pieces are complete, you will learn her invisible machine appliqué technique. This is the style of appliqué that Karen uses on all her machine appliqué quilts. Karen will also help you decide on some fun quilting motifs. You will leave with a project ready for quilting at home.

Kit fee: \$25 (kit includes pattern, foundation paper, glue stick, and fine-line glue) – kit fee is payable to teacher at class

Supplies:

Sewing machine in working order with zig-zag stitch ability (I use Microtex Sharp 90/14 needle)

Open toe foot

Basic sewing supplies

Pencil for tracing pattern pieces

Invisible thread (your preferred brand)

Thin thread for bobbin (I prefer 100wt thread)

Fabrics for project in your choice of colors

½ yard of ombre hand-dye was used for sample. There will be five rings for this project – if not using ombre fabric, fat quarters for each color will suffice.

Background fabric approximately 24x24

Orange wood/cuticle stick

Compact iron and pressing surface

Scissors (we will be cutting foundation paper and fabric)
